Evaluate collected data regarding the medical or psychiatric plan of treatment, available social service programs and knowledge of casework or group work.

Participate in clinical rounds, meetings, conferences, consultations and educational programs designed to increase knowledge and to improve patient care and staff performance; serve as a consultant to physicians and staff members regarding services in the specialty area. Develop and coordinate in-service educational programs for the Spinal Cord Injury Team, Heart Transplant Program, psychology interns and support staff; develop therapeutic programs to assist patient and family adjust to problems associated with acute hospitalization.

Assist in the development of procedures and guidelines as needed .

Prepare reports and analyses setting forth progress, adverse trends and appropriate recommendations or conclusions.

Plan and implement therapeutic programs to assist patients and their families, through individual or group conferences, to understand, accept and follow therapy plans.

Maintain liaison with various local and regional health care agencies.

Assist physicians in performing direct patient care upon request.

Perform other related duties incidental to the work described herein.
